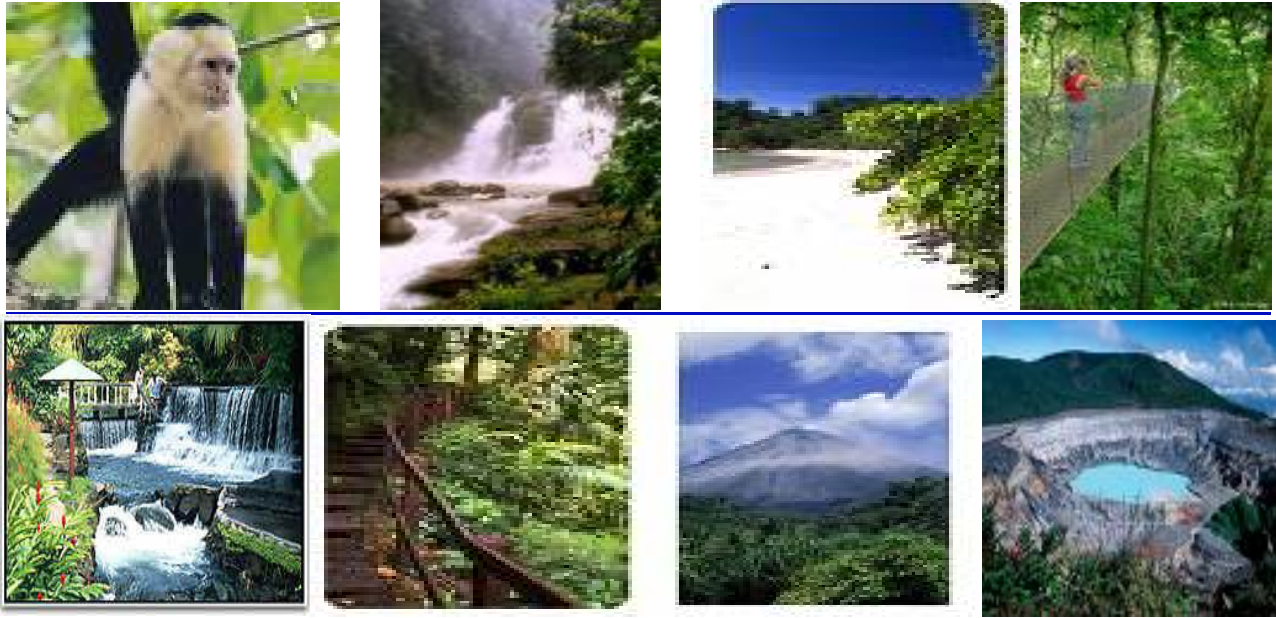


COSTA RICA

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Price includes: Round trip airfare, LAX to San Jose, 8 night hotel accommodations, (2 nights in Arenal, 2 nights in Monteverde, 1 night in Quepos, 3 nights in Playa Tambor); 8 breakfasts, 3 lunches, 5 dinners; Chartered bus, sightseeing; English speaking tour guide; entrance to Poas Volcano, and a naturalist guided tour at the Arenal hanging bridges, the Monteverde Cloud Forest and famous the Manuel Antonio Natural Park.

Day 1: Sat Nov 3: (D) After arriving in San Jose, we will board a chartered bus and be whisked away to the Poas Volcano for a breathtaking view of the volcano's turquoise crater lake. We continue our exciting journey to Tabacon Hot Springs Resort for dinner and relax in the warmth of flowing thremo-mineral waters in the resort's therapeutic pools with temperatures ranging from 74-105 degrees. Envision a sky illuminated by volcanic eruptions. Imagine yourself in this magical setting with the added luxury of outstanding facilities and exceptional service. This is Tabacon, where we will spend our first two nights. The main pool has a swim up bar for a nightcap, while we view the mini eruptions of the volcano which may entertain us with its natural show of fireworks.

Day 2: Sun Nov 4: (B.D) This is your free day to pamper yourself or to try exciting new experiences:

Leisure at this wonderful paradise resort or there are exciting options that you can choose:

- ❖ Pampering yourself with a spa treatment and massage at the resort
- ❖ Rappel down into several waterfalls ranging from a height of 60 to 150 feet
- ❖ Whitewater River rafting
- ❖ Hike in the late afternoon to the Arenal Volcano lava fields

We will convene for a group dinner in La Fortuna, afterwards soak in the warmth of the natural warm pools and waterfalls, conversing with each other about our day of exiting experiences.

Day 3: Mon Nov 5: (B) In the morning we head for an easy 2-mile hike with a naturalist guide across the Arenal Hanging Bridges, through the rain forest. The trail offers close up views of the tropical forest from the ground to the tree top canopy. In the afternoon we board our chartered bus and travel to the Monteverde Cloud Forest Preserve that traverses the Tilarán Mountain Range, which is part of the Continental Divide. The area has been named Monteverde, "Green Mountain", since that is what travelers find at the end of the ride up the winding road. The Preserve is a 5,000-hectare wildlife sanctuary, with plentiful birds, insects and mammals. We will travel through Costa Rica's interior to El Establo, a hotel near the Monteverde Cloud Forest.

Day 4: Tues Nov 6:(B) We will start our day with a naturalist guide exploring the Monteverde Cloud Forest. In the cloud forest there are more than 100 species of mammals, 400 species of birds, including 30 kinds of hummingbirds. The area is acclaimed as the most outstanding wildlife refuge in the New World Tropics. In the afternoon you can go hiking, exploring, canopying, suspension bridges, horseback riding are just some of your options in the surrounding area. If you are up for excitement, head for the optional Canopy Tour, zipping through the treetops, a once in a lifetime experience. In the evening if you still have some energy you can go on an optional two hour guided night tour in the Monteverde Cloud Forest.

Day 5: Wed Nov 7: (B) After our two nights in Monteverde we will take a chartered bus along the Pacific Coast and head to our new home in a hotel within the vicinity of Manuel Antonio National Park, one of the most beautiful parks in Costa Rica and is known as “Jewel of Costa Rica” with its white sandy beaches, tall evergreen forests, cliffs, crystal clear water and a mangrove swamp which characterize the endless beauty found in the park. We can spend our afternoon on the pristine beach, enjoying tropical drinks as we watch the sunset.

Day 6: Thurs Nov 8: (B,D) Start our day observing the morning ritual habits of the squirrel monkeys, capuchin monkeys, sloths, toucans and scarlet macaws on a naturalist guided tour of Manuel Antonio National Park. Depart to Punterans and catch the early evening ferry and cross the Nicoya Peninsula to Playa Tambor which is right on the Pacific Coast of Costa Rica, located in a natural, incredibly beautiful setting to the All-Inclusive Barceló Tambor Beach Resort. It has a 4 mile long beach surrounded by several natural reserves.

Day 7 & 8: Fri and Sat Nov 9-10: (B,L,D)/(B,L,D) The next two days enjoy the natural settings and incredible beach of our all-inclusive resort. Lie down under the tropical sun, dedicate a day to your favorite sport, or head out on an excursion. Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are included, including typical regional cuisine.

Unlimited local beverages (such as, fizzy drinks, beer, liquors, local cocktails, soda, water, and coffee) are provided.

You can enjoy group sport activities or relax in the Jacuzzi or take a swim in the pool at the resort’s facilities.

Some of the exciting tour options that you can choose from:

- ❖ Visit the Bohemian village of Montezuma, where you can see the craftsmanship of its artisans in its picturesque streets. After exploring the village, hike to a beautiful waterfall and take a refreshing dip in its pool.

Group dinner each night and afterwards we can enjoy the resort’s night time entertainment program or party at the Disco.

Day 9: Sun Nov 11: (B,L) Depart for the ferry to Puntarenas, then an enjoy a buffet lunch, then visit the Chaverri factory, the best wood workshop near Sarchi, and then our adventure comes to an end as we head to the airport for a non-stop flight home to LA.
