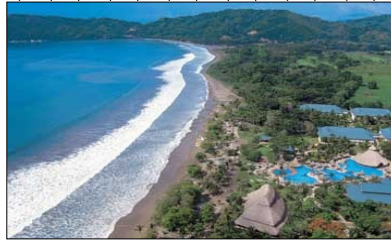

Exit the Venture (101) freeway at Wendy Drive. Turn left and go 2 miles to Lynn Road. Turn right on Lynn Road and go 2 miles to the Circle "K" stables located on the left at 4790 West Lynn Road, Newbury Park. It is suggested that carpoolers meet at the Palm Garden Hotel parking lot by 9:30AM. To the Alamo restaurant from the stables: Turn right on Lynn Road and go 2 miles to Wendy Drive. Turn left on Wendy Drive and go 1.3 miles to Borchard Road. Turn right on Borchard Road and go 1 mile to Michael Drive. Turn left on Michael Drive and then immediately turn left into the Alamo parking lot.

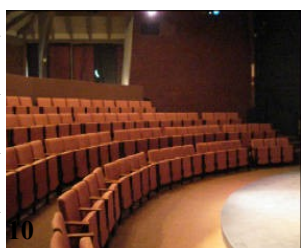

CONDUCT POLICY OF THE CONEJO SKI & SPORTS CLUB
