Solstice Canyon leads to the Tropical Keller house which was destroyed by a fire. The stone courtyard garden terrace and exotic tropical plants still remain. Near the ruins, a waterfall, cascades 30 feet over sandstone rocks. The trail meanders through a lush canyon to a sweeping vista of the Pacific Ocean.

The hike is 6.2 miles roundtrip with an elevation gain of 1,100 feet.

Directions: *Ventura Freeway (101) to Kanan Rd exit. Turn into the carpool lot across from Burger King.*

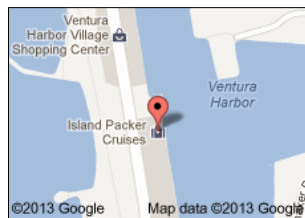

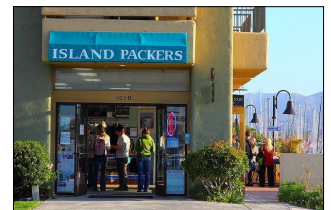

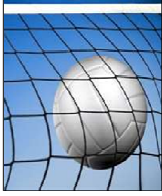

CONDUCT POLICY OF THE CONEJO SKI & SPORTS CLUB
