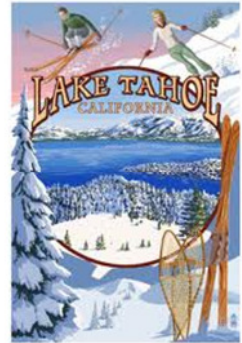

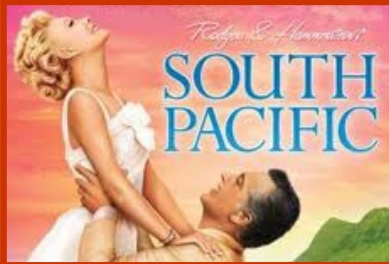

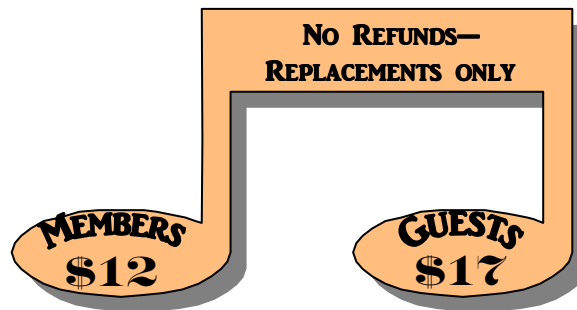

## **CONDUCT POLICY OF THE CONEJO SKI & SPORTS CLUB**
