In consideration of being allowed to participate, in any way, in the Conejo Ski & Sports Club programs related events, and activities I, (Participant's Name Printed) the Undersigned acknowledge, appreciate, and agree that:
1. The risk of injury from many of the activities is significant, including the potential for permanent paralysi and death, and while particular skills, rules, equipment, and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious injury does exist; and,
2. I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown, EVEN II ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES or others and assume full responsibility for my participation; and,
3. I willingly agree to comply with the stated and customary terms and conditions for participation. It however, I observe any unusual significant hazard during my presence or participation, I will remove mysel from participation and bring such to the attention of the nearest official immediately; and,
4. 





The 2020 Banff-Lake Louise Trip Installment Plan is as follows: A non-refundable \$370 deposit is due upon first sign-up; a non-refundable 2<sup>nd</sup> installment of \$700 is due October 16, 2019, a non-refundable 3<sup>rd</sup> final base payment of \$700 is due December 4, 2019. Ski ticket choices +/or additional breakfast vouchers will be due by January 15, 2020. 




