





Reservation and Payment Schedule:

A \$200 deposit check per person, made payable to "CSSC", with your signed registration form and wavier forms is required to confirm a reservation. A second payment of \$500 is due by June 30, 2021. Final payment is due by March 7, 2022

Cancellation & Refund Policy: For the Group Land Package:

Cancellations of a 120 days or more prior to departure is \$250 non-refundable, refundable only with a replacement; Cancellations from 120 days to March 6, 2022 is \$350; Cancellations from March 7, 2022 the full group land package is non-refundable unless a replacement is found.

Trip deposits/installment payments are non-refundable unless you obtain a replacement and there is no cost to CSSC. Replacements are the responsibility of the trip member who cancels, not the responsibility of CSSC.

*Conejo Ski & Sports Club", recommends that you purchase "Trip Insurance". You can purchase trip insurance with an option, "Cancel for Any Reason", but YOU MUST purchase this type of insurance within 14 days of your initial deposit check date.






