
	In consideration of being allowed to participate, in any way, in the Conejo Ski & Sports Club programs related events, and activities I, (Participant's Name Printed) the Undersigned acknowledge, appreciate, and agree that:
	1. The risk of injury from many of the activities is significant, including the potential for permanent paralysi and death, and while particular skills, rules, equipment, and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious injury does exist; and,
	2. I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown, EVEN II ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES or others and assume full responsibility for my participation; and,
	3. I willingly agree to comply with the stated and customary terms and conditions for participation. If however, I observe any unusual significant hazard during my presence or participation, I will remove mysel from participation and bring such to the attention of the nearest official immediately; and,
	4. I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS Conejo Ski & Sports Club, their officers, officials, agents, and/o employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and, if applicable, owners and leasers of premises used to conduct the event ("RELEASEES"), WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALI INJURY, DISABILITY, DEATH, LOSS OR DAMAGE TO PERSON OR PROPERTY, WHETHER ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE, to the fullest extended by law.
	Activity participant agrees that this release will apply to all known and unknown as well as unanticipated claims, injures and damages resulting from club activities, as well as, those now disclosed and all rights unde section 1542 of the Civil Code of California are hereby expressly waived. Section 1542 of the Civil Code of California reads as follows:
	"A general release does not extend to claims which the (person signing the release) does not know of suspect to exist in his (or her) favor, at the time of execution of the release, which if known by him (or her) must have materially affected his (or her) signing the release."
	In addition, I have read, understand and agree to the Conejo Ski & Sports Club (CSSC) Conduct Policy which states: "All participants are required to observe common courtesy and generally accepted standards of behavior. CSSC will not tolerate violation of any federal, state, or local laws or ordinances. Illegal use of drug, tobacco or alcohol will cause the participant to be removed from the event. Additionally, CSSC will not reimburse the participant for any forfeited payments. CSSC may also choose, for the benefit of all participants, to prohibit smoking or alcohol at events. Participants who display obnoxious or offensive behavior in violation of this conduct policy, as determined by the CSSC event representative, may be removed and/or isolated from the group. Your Board of Directors At Work

Dues Increase Notice:

At their January 11th meeting, the Board passed a motion to raise annual membership dues to \$50 per person effective February 1, 2023.

There are a number of reasons for this dues hike, which, by the way, is the first dues increase in about 30 years which remained at \$40. First, the room rental price has gone up at Palm Garden Hotel, and is scheduled to go up again in July after the restaurant is open. Second, we pay approximately \$15 per person every year for liability insurance. Third, we pay a monthly fee for a storage locker to house various club supplies. The cost of these three things exceeds the \$40 each member pays in dues. Yes, we have the raffle, but it's not the moneymaker you may think it is. It brings in minimal profit; not enough to cover the difference in costs per person.

April 19, 2022



Ballots will be available in the April Newsletter, on-line and also at the club meetings.









A \$700 deposit check per person, made payable to "Conejo Ski & Sports Club", with your signed registration form and the CSSC wavier forms is required to confirm a reservation. A second payment of \$1000 is due by March 15, 2023. Final payment is due by June 30, 2023. **Note: Trip deposits/installment payments are non-refundable unless you obtain a replacement and there is no cost to CSSC. Replacements are the responsibility of the trip member who cancels, not the responsibility of CSSC.**

Cancellation & Refund Policy:

Collette Cancellation Charges for this tour, if you did not purchase Collette Travel Protection Insurance: Deposits are not refundable unless you find a replacement. For cancellation between 60-16 days prior to departure: cancellation fee of 40% of total price. For cancellation between 15-1 days prior to departure: cancellation fee of 75% of total price. They were mean-spirited, sarcastic, and cynical - each card was decorated with a caricature of a certain type of person accompanied by a cruel, insulting poem that usually rhymed. On a positive note, they reportedly helped promote literacy among the lower classes during the 19th century.
